

## Annual Grade Calculation

Using the point system:

A=4

B=3

C=2

D=1

Minimum points needed for **Annual Classes**..... and then for **Semester Classes**

14 pts.....= A =.....7 pts

10 pts.....= B =.....5 pts

6 pts.....= C =.....3 pts

4 pts.....= D =.....2 pts

Example:

If you get a C in the first 9 weeks, a B in the second 9 weeks, and a B in the third 9 weeks...What will you need on the fourth 9 weeks in order to get a final grade of a B?

Well...a C = 2 points, a B = 3 points, and another B = 3 more points. That is 8 points so far.

What does it say on the chart that a student needs for a B? Minimum 10 points in an annual class...So the student only needs a C in the fourth 9 weeks in order to end up with a B avg.!

Also...for the second semester rule....A student needs 2 D's or at least one C, for that is a D average (2 points on my system.)
